The love of Christ for Iran and beyond

Every day, Iranians are coming to Christ.

Every week, new house churches are being born in Iran, despite persecution.

Elam exists to strengthen and expand this rapidly growing church.

Much is happening, but -with your help- many more can be reached and discipled in the heart of the Muslim world. Did you know that the number of Christians in Iran has increased exponentially since the fall of the Shah in 1979?

Or that life for a Christian in Iran is exceedingly tough?

Or that, since 1990, Elam Ministries has been providing literature, Bibles, training, and encouragement to Christians both inside Iran and in neighbouring countries where many Iranians spend their holidays?

Or that there is a thriving Iranian church in the UK?

Or that young Iranians (making up a quarter of the population), disillusioned with the current political, religious and economic situation, are more open to the Gospel than ever before?

Or that it took 20 years, and much suffering and hard work and enemy opposition, to translate the Bible into modern Persian?

For new believers, experiencing devotion through music is entirely new. Tens of thousands of believers tune into programmes on social media and satellite TV, and non-believers are also intrigued by the joyful singing. Some of these programmes are also broadcast into Afghanistan! Viewers send testimonies and videos, even though it is dangerous to do so, of how worship songs have impacted their hearts and helped them endure seasons of hardship.

In a situation where new believers could easily fall away without encouragement, Elam's 3 month one-to-one Safar courses are used to disciple many new believers and produce many leaders each year, and many more received advanced training. Encouraged by church-planting initiatives, and in response to the follow-up ministry to the programmes broadcast into the region, including weekly Bible, women's and children's programmes, the number of house churches inside Iran has grown exponentially, and this despite intense persecution.

All fellowships need the Word of God, and Elam has not been idle there: 2.5 New Testaments have been printed since 2003. These were distributed all over Iran and to Persian-speaking refugees and visitors in neighbouring countries. And Elam's correspondence courses are helping hundreds of new believers to learn about Jesus and grown in their walk with God. Hundreds of new Iranian and Afghan believers have been baptised in recent months in cities across the region. The large-scale baptisms have been occasions of great joy and celebration, often lasting from morning to evening. And there are more to come! And young people have come to Christ via football!

But there is nothing to stop them watching television or the internet. And in a country where life for women is very difficult, counselling on-line is also provided.

There are of course Iranian refugees in many European countries, and Elam does its best to cater for them too through discipleship conferences and leadership courses. Some of these refugees eventually return to Iran and plant house churches and fellowships there, or are involved in broadcasting programmes into Iran often through social media. And Elam has partnered with over three hundred churches and mission agencies in Europe. Not to mention the hundred thousand New Testaments that have been distributed in the continent.
